Aeon's First 100% Renewable Energy-Powered Stores to Start Operations Aeon style Ebie and Aeon Fujiidera Shopping center

Aeon is starting its first-ever facility operations that are fully powered by renewable energy at two stores: Aeon style Ebie (open: March 28, 2020; operator: Aeon Retail Co., Ltd.) and Aeon Fujiidera Shopping Center (open: September 14, 2019; operator: Aeon Mall Co., Ltd.).

This marks a milestone towards Aeon Decarbonization Vision 2050, our commitment to achieving net zero greenhouse gas emissions from store operations by 2050, which was announced in March 2018. It is also to serve the purpose of RE 100, an international initiative to accelerate the shift to renewable electricity on a global scale, for which Aeon is Japan's first major retail partner.

In addition to taking new measures to conserve energy, each of the stores has laid out an appropriate renewable electricity procurement plan. Aeon Fujiidera Shopping Center has introduced a solar power generation system, adopting a PPA scheme as its primary supply source. It has also signed up for Kansai Electric Power Company's Renewable Energy ECO Plan to supplement the energy output from the solar power system. Aeon Style Ebie has also started using renewable energy by signing up for the same plan.

Aiming to create a decarbonized society, Aeon will promote group-wide efforts in various areas, such as expanding the use of renewable energy.
