Presentation of Emergency Disaster Relief Donation for People Affected by the Earthquake in Sichuan

Today on Monday, April 22, Aeon will make an emergency disaster relief donation to support the recovery of victims of the magnitude 7.0 earthquake that occurred in Sichuan in People's Republic of China (hereinafter "China").

On Saturday, April 20, a large earthquake hit Luchan, Yaan City, Sichuan in China and caused landslides and collapse of houses. According to local reports, as many as 1.5 million people suffered damage and a lot of people lost their lives due to the disaster as of Monday, April 22. In the afflicted areas, many people, who evacuated from their houses, are leading inconvenient lives without the supply of enough food or tents.

In response, Aeon will make an emergency disaster relief donation to the Embassy of China in Japan, hoping to support the recovery and restoration of the afflicted areas from the disaster.

Also at Aeon stores in China, donations for the victims will be collected from customers for the period from today to Sunday, May 5.

Aeon has been continuously conducting activities to deepen friendship between Japanese and Chinese citizens, including planting 1 million trees around the Beijing Great Wall of China, fostering exchanges between Japanese and Chinese students who will be the next leaders, and granting scholarships to Chinese students who are eager to learn in both of the countries.

Also to the victims of the large earthquake that occurred in Sichuan in 2008, Aeon made donations, including an emergency aid from the company and donation from its customers.
