# Melina Sakiyama



From an early age, Melina Sakiyama has been intrigued by the fine and complex balance between the planet and all its inhabitants. This childhood awe bloomed into a deep love with nature. It was the beginning of her journey to seek for deeper understanding of this web of life and to engage as many people as possible in this collective vision of life in harmony within nature.

Born and raised in Sao Paulo, Brazil, Melina's interest in Biodiversity was sparked through trips to her father's home town in the Amazon, where she was able to see and enjoy the sheer endless diversity of nature. However, her upbringing also made her aware of the human impact on nature. As the daugther of a marine who served in Brazil's merchant navy, Melina's early childhood was characterized by journeys around the world on a cargo ship. Through these journeys, she was able to develop a deep understanding of how everything on our planet is connected with each other. How globalization, consumption and production patterns impact biodiversity.

These experiences shaped Melina's personality, her values, her outlook on the world and her further upbringing.

Wanting to turn her love for nature into a profession, Melina pursued a degree in Biology at the University of Sao Paulo where she contributed to research on the role of biologists in environmental issues. Following her graduation, she was awarded a Nikkei Scholarship from Nippon Foundation and received a Master's Degree in Environmental Management at Kyoto University in Japan. At Kyoto University, Melina focused on biodiversity education, biodiversity valuation and ways to engage youth.

After graduating from Kyoto University, Melina worked as a Science Officer for Diversitas/Future Earth from 2014 to 2015. At Diversitas/Future Earth she was responsible for assisting the implementation of the bioGENESIS programme.

While in Japan, Melina interned with the Japan Council for the UN Decade on Education for Sustainable Development as well as the UNESCO office in Bangkok, where she was able to deepen her knowledge about biodiversity and education.

During her time in Japan, Melina was also selected to participate in the 2010 International Youth Conference on Biodiversity (IYCB) in Nagoya, where she met other young biodiversity activists from all over the world who shared her views and values towards Biodiversity, and together with cofounder Christian Schwarzer, they both started leading a small group of participants that developed the idea to create a Global Youth Biodiversity Network (GYBN).

Inspired by her participation in the 2010 UN Biodiversity Summit (CBD COP10) in 2010, she dedicated a great part of her life in the next ten years to establish and consolidate GYBN and build a global movement for young people to empower themselves to get engaged in biodiversity issues and pursue the vision of a collective and just future in harmony within nature.


