Information on Relief Supplies Provided in Response to The 2016 Kumamoto Earthquake (Third Report)

We pray sincerely for all those who lost their lives due to The 2016 Kumamoto Earthquake, and extend our deep sympathies and condolences to those affected by the Earthquake.

A large number of aftershocks still continue in the Kumamoto areas, and many people are constrained to evacuate. Concerns over expanding damages including collapsing houses and landslides are mounting.

The initiative of delivering blankets to people affected by the disaster to a relief supply collection point, Kumamoto Prefecture Recreation Park "Umakana-Yokana Stadium" is carried out based on the Agreement on Emergency Disaster Relief between Aeon Kyushu Co., Ltd. and Kumamoto City in response to a request for emergency relief supplies from the City.

The blankets are transported to Kumamoto Airport in cooperation with Japan Airlines Corporation, and then delivered to the relief supply collection point by a truck in cooperation with Japan Ground Self-Defense Force in response to the request from Kumamoto City.

Aeon continues to provide disaster relief responding to requests in cooperation with partner organizations and corporations utilizing its know-how and network.

2. The 2016 Kumamoto Earthquake emergency disaster relief and recovery fund-raising
